

Extra spots for Young Members in AIPPI's Standing Committees

AIPPI is continuously looking at ways to increase the engagement of its membership and in this respect from now on there will be extra spots for young members in AIPPI's Standing Committees! All Standing Committees will going forward accept an additional member if that member is a young member.

Simply put, the current **"2+1 rule"** (2 private practitioners plus 1 in-house or academic) is expanded to a **"2+1+1"** rule, meaning that a fourth member may be appointed if that member is aged 36 years or below (see the full Standing Committee Protocol, in particular article 3, [here](#)).

If you are a young member and are interested in joining a Standing Committee, please contact the leadership of your group and indicate that you are interested in being nominated. Additionally, of course the option remains to become an observer in any Standing Committee (you can do so by clicking on "Contact" on aippi.org and then selecting "Becoming an observer of a committee" from the drop-down list of options in the form).
