Scan the Globe is planned as a series of webinars to be started as a part of the AIPPI 125th anniversary activities, which will begin in 2022 with at least two separate webinars and will last into 2023. The purpose is to give AIPPI members access to information about IP laws and practices around the world, especially regarding developments in lesser-known jurisdictions/regions, and share recent litigation cases to show the implementation of the law and where certain decisions made during IP prosecution can affect later enforcement

- Outline of IP systems and applicable treaties
